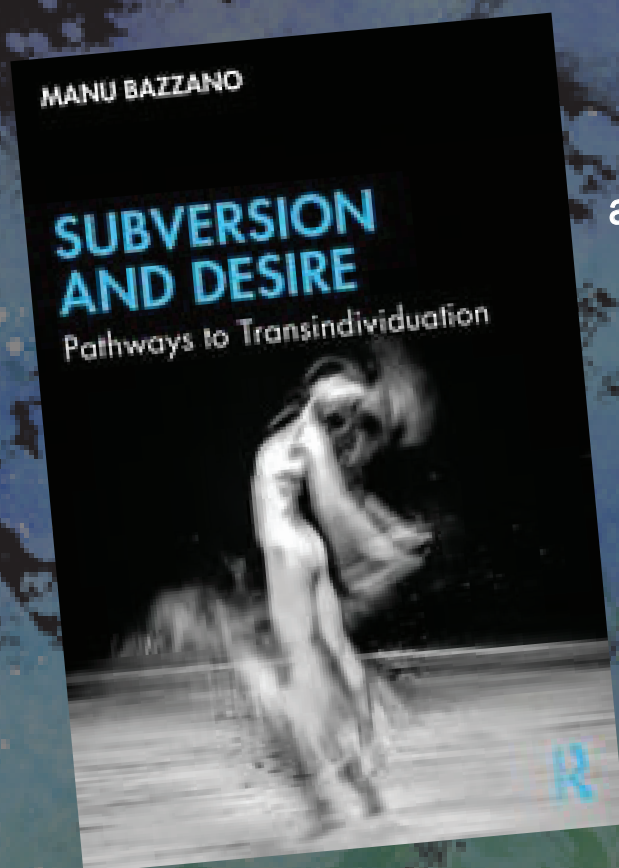


Subversion and Desire: Pathways towards Transindividuation
